The HUB - Rani

In February next year the first HUB will open that Holly Cade had told us about. It will be in the Pastures Day Centre in Goole. This is the first one, called the PILOT.

There will be stands and a chance to meet with other friends and families and learn about what's going on e.g. Partnership Boards, Fit Mums Walks, Being healthy...

In the future there will be 7 Hubs - one in each Primary Care Network (groups of GP Practices that are working together).

- **Bridlington** - Field House Surgery, Humber Primary Care, Drs Reddy & Nunn (Practice 3), Wolds View Surgery
- **Holderness Health** - one GP Practice, Holderness Health, covers this area (Hedon to Withernsea)
- **Harthill** - Anlaby Surgery, King Street Medical Centre, Market Weighton Practice, North Ferriby Surgery, Park View Surgery, Willerby and Swanland Surgery
- **River and Wolds** - the Ridings Medical Group
