


     	<p>Speak up group have written to East Yorkshire buses about route and bus number changes and how it affects us.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Staff financial forum update, (Peter) Peter told us that the council had £154 million last year and £166 million this year to spend on Adult Social Care. No one has told him how it will be spent yet. Health Joint Care reviews Pilot (Rani) Bridlington Pilot has finished, and Rani is looking at what went well. She will have to make sure they carry on going well. Goole will be next to pilot, but they need funding first. Love your Life Event - Bridlington (Trish) The next is in Bridlington on 18th June and they asked if we would like a stall. Peter is going to ask them for posters to share. Our Place Update (Trish) Clare told us that the website will have the new look in July. They are making safeguarding videos with people in the day services for Our Place. When they make videos for Independence they would like some actors. Anna, Paul and Conrad want to help, and Su knows actors in Beechwood that would help too. RADAR KEYS - Disabled Toilets (Trish) Conrad showed everyone what a Radar key is and that you can buy them online or from Customer services. Trish shared a printout of all Public toilets in the East Riding but not Hull. Paul told everyone that there are a lot of toilets in Hull. Food and drink costs more. (It's on each week)</p> <p>RED has stayed £5 for entry and food and drinks cost more. They have discos and sometimes singers.</p> <p>When we want to go to social clubs, we must pay for the club staff to go with us, transport, drinks... Less people go now, they don't have enough money.</p> <p>People that live in Residential Care might only have £25 left after their bills, and they use that for toiletries, treats, holidays, clothes, activities...</p>	<p>Everyone Think ... Who can help? What can we do?</p>
 	<p>Oliver McGowan Training (Julia)</p> <p>Julia told us that health and social care staff must complete the face-to-face training (Tier 2). It will help staff to listen and respect our choices.</p> <p>Julia told us about how Oliver died and that his mum, Paula wants to stop this happening to anybody else.</p> <p>Oliver died because doctors didn't listen to Oliver or read his notes or Hospital Passport.</p> <p>Julia has visited places that are doing the training, and their staff have visited Julia - the training must be the same for everyone.</p> <p>1200 council staff will start doing their training from June.</p> <p>We still need experts and facilitators - tell us if you want to learn.</p>	<p>Everyone Tell Trish if you want to be an expert or trainer</p>
