



Children's diagnosis

 Children with ADHD can be referred by their school, through the 'right to choose pathway', or by their GP. More work needs doing to understand pressures and factors for referring.

Functional Impact Criteria

- A new set of rules (criteria) is being made about how ADHD affects people. It is important to talk to the public about these rules.
- The public's ideas and thoughts will help make the rules better and more helpful.





Autism Voice feedback

Data and Life changes

 The group talked about the need for better data on autistic people and the impact of life changes e.g. late diagnosis and transitions.

Workplace accommodations

 They talked about how important it is for reasonable adjustments, and others understanding differences e.g. sensory differences.

GP Visits

- The group shared bad experiences with their GP.
- No person-centred care.
- They need Health Passports to support them.
