

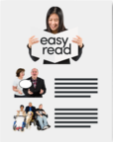

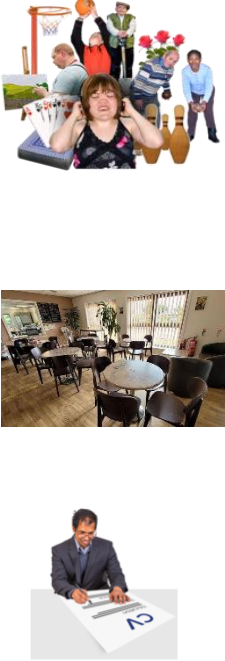

(see presentation) Worklink have- • Training areas eg Garden, Horticulture, Catering, Hospitality, Customer service... • Referral process, must be 18 years or older • Eligibility Criteria - diagnosis of Learning Disability or Autism • Supported Internship opportunities They can help people write a CV, apply for a job., complete training or provide experience	Susannah Sarah Sue
