Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training



My name is Ali. I am the Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training Administrator for Inclusion North in the North East.



The Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training on Learning Disability and Autism has been created following the death of Oliver McGowan in 2016.



Oliver McGowan was a young autistic man with a mild learning disability who died because he was not given the correct treatment while in hospital.



The Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training has been developed and is delivered by people with a learning disability and autistic people.



The Oliver McGowan Mandatory Training will be delivered to health and social care staff.



Inclusion North are working with The Learning Disability Network and The Integrated Care Board to organise the training in the North East and North Cumbria.



We are working with 6 local self-advocacy groups who are employing people with lived experience to deliver the training.



The training is delivered by a facilitating trainer, a person with a learning disability and an autistic person.



There are two tiers of training. Tier 1 includes a 90-minute e-Learning for Health module and a 1-hour online webinar.



Tier 2 includes a 90-minute e-Learning for Health module and 1 day of face-to-face training.
