One of the groups I'm supporting in the North East is the Involvement Leaders.




The Involvement Leaders all have lived experience of using specialist hospital services, like assessment and treatment units or secure services. Some are in hospital now or have been in the past.

The Involvement Leaders have written a list of priorities. These include:

- Less restraint and seclusion rooms not to be used
- Supporting people to be involved in meetings where decisions are made about their lives

The Integrated Care Board want to listen to the group's priorities and experiences to make services in the North East better.
