# **How Safeguarding works**

A member of staff will contact you to find out what has happened and what you would like to happen next. You may require information or want a full enquiry to take place. You will be involved in all stages of the process.

You will be involved in an enquiry as will any of your family and friends if you wish them to be. You can choose whether you want to be involved in the enquiry. The person leading the enquiry will ask you if you want further support.

You will be invited to participate in meetings. You may attend alone, with a representative or someone can attend on your behalf. If you choose not to attend your views will be represented and you will be advised of the outcome.
